**Agreement:**

The undersigned hereby agrees to comply with the provisions contained in Title 5 of the Environmental Code and The Town of Middleborough Regulations in addition to Title 5 providing that equipment shall be subject to the inspection and approval of The Board of Health.

- a. Permit holders shall provide the Health Dept. a monthly report due by the 15<sup>th</sup> of the following month listing all pumping within the Town of Middleborough, location of pumping, date of pumping, source (Septic Tank, Grease trap, etc.), gallons pumped and location of ultimate disposal.
- b. Every Truck used for hauling/pumping septage shall have clearly visible site glass and all hoses and fittings in good repair with no leaks.
